What is the Legacy Club?

The Legacy Club is a way of recognizing individuals who wish to assist in the establishment of a lasting legacy to help children and adults who are visually or hearing impaired. How do I become a Legacy Club member?

- an assignee of part of your pension/retirement fund, IRA, insurance policy, or investment account.
