Dear Club Secretary,

Enclosed is your 2019 Candy Day information packet. **2019 CANDY DAY** will be **October 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>** – the second Friday and Saturday in October.

In this packet, you are receiving all the information needed to have a successful Candy Day. We have included materials in helping to get businesses to allow you to collect in front of their stores. Also included is a contribution request form for Casey's General Stores and a volunteer request form from Kohl's for you to utilize.

We need your help and support to make the 2019 Candy Day a **GREAT** success. Last year our net income was \$322,000.00. Our goal for 2019 is \$325,000.00. We can only do this if we have all of your help and support.

Your Foundation this year has added a sugar free sucker to the campaign. The sugar free sucker will have the Foundation's logo on the wrapper. A 3lb box will contain 350 suckers at a cost of \$45/case, which includes shipping. In addition, a 15lb box will contain 1050 suckers at a cost of \$95 plus shipping. Your Foundation will also have the traditional wintergreen candy rolls, which will contain 576 rolls at \$95 /case plus shipping. All of the candy and supplies can be picked up at your District Jamboree. If you cannot make it to the Jamboree please contact your district Trustees for other arrangements for candy and supplies delivery.

Try to plan and get your orders in early. Begin now, get every member involved, and try to find outside volunteers to help on Candy Day. Try to increase underwriting over the previous year. Submit in advance, publicity to radio, and TV stations. Please remember to obtain a permit allowing solicitations in your city or town.
