

CHICAGO LIGHTHOUSE SEEING IS BELIEVING UPDATE

The Chicago Lighthouse

We are happy to say we are still able to have in-person clinics for our students and families.

The CPS clinics will be held at the main Lighthouse and we are in contact with the vision coordinator to schedule those.

In total CPS and 4 other school board vision coordinators have been contacted to schedule their clinics. Some of the schools are pushing things back as far as a commitment date in hopes that their schools will be open for some in person learning which will allow our clinics to be there. This will likely lead to us being busier this winter and early spring.

JACKSONVILLE STUDENT LOW VISION CLINIC UPDATE





The Lions of Illinois Endowment Trust offers the opportunity for members of the Lions family and the general public to give a tax-deductible gift that keeps on giving. It is a restricted fund in which contributions are pooled and invested, with the principal remaining intact. Only the income can be used to support Lions of Illinois Foundation programs and services for people with vision and hearing needs.

Endowment Trust Mission Statement:

The Lions of Illinois Endowment Trust exists for the sole purpose of creating a consistent and permanent stream of revenue to fund the programs and services provided by the Lions for the visually and hearing impaired. It is recognized that future unmet human needs may need to be addressed and the Lions may not be able to affect those needs directly. Therefore, the Lions of Illinois through this Trust are creating a present day capability for those future needs.

Merrill Lynch: For the past 21 years with the help and support of the management team at Merrill Lynch, your Endowment Trust has been steady at **13.4** million dollars as of **1-11-2021**. Your Foundation only takes 3% of the earned income towards the programs and services of your Lions of Illinois Foundation,

97% of the earned income is rolled back into the fund for future needs.

Foundation Fellows

A Foundation Fellow is the greatest level of recognition that can be bestowed by the Lions of Illinois Foundation and can honor anyone (Lion or non-Lion). It can be presented to a person who donates \$500 to the Lions of Illinois Endowment Trust, or it can be used as a way for others to honor a person's dedication to the club, community, Lions District, Lions of Illinois Foundation, and/ or Lionism in general. For those who wish to contribute more than \$500 or to begin a program of giving, there are 25 levels of the Foundation Fellow, with each level attained affording honor to the individual named.

What does the Foundation Fellow receive?

For the initial \$500 donation, the person named as a Foundation Fellow receives a pin, patch, chevron and beautiful engraved plaque. For each progressive level, the person will receive a pin and chevron. The person's name is also listed in a computerized scrolling role of honorees located at the Lions of Illinois Foundation.

What is a Sustaining Supporter?

The Sustaining Supporter program is a method of giving in which anyone (Lion or non-Lion) is encouraged to give a tax-deductible donation on an annual basis to help support the many programs and services of the Lions of Illinois Foundation. With the annual contribution of \$25 (less than 7ϕ per day) through the Sustaining Supporter program, an individual is able to demonstrate a commitment to the Lions of Illinois Foundation and to its vision of creating a permanent vehicle for the delivery of programs and services to the visually and hearing impaired. The initial \$25 contribution entitles the Sustaining Supporter to receive a pin. Upon renewal, the Sustaining Supporter receives a numbered tab that may be attached to the pin.


