

Mobile Hearing/Vision Screening Unit

The Lions of Illinois places a Mobile Hearing/Retinal Unit on the road from March 1st through October 31st every year. For the purpose of detecting hearing loss/deafness and detecting eye diseases such as Macular Degeneration and Diabetic Retinopathy. Hearing Aid Bank

In cooperation with the University of Illinois Chicago Audiology Department, LIF has established the Hearing Aid Bank (HAB). The HAB is kept supplied through the donations of hearing aids, which are reconditioned and cataloged for the bank or are sold for salvage to offset the costs. The HAB provides assistance to individuals who cannot afford to purchase a hearing aid, or do not qualify to receive aid from a state or federal agency.

Student Low Vision Program -Since 1976

Since 1976, The Low Vision Program for has performed FREE Students comprehensive visual evaluations. helping severely visually impaired students make the most of their sight. Students remaining from kindergarten through twelfth grade gain a better understanding and awareness of their vision loss. Low Vision optometrists travel to the screening locations throughout Illinois, bringing equipment for examinations & demonstrations. The program furthers a visually impaired youth's ability to increase their academic potential, enrich their social skills, and helps with employment opportunities. future Above all, the Low Vision Program for Students helps address their daily challenges growing up with vision loss.
