Mobile Hearing/Vision Screening Unit

Since 1983, the Lions of Illinois Foundation has had a Mobile Unit on the road to screen for the prevention of eye disease. Today the unit is on the road for the purpose of detecting and preventing both vision and hearing loss. The mobile multi-use (hearing/retinal) screening unit is on the road from March 1st through October 31st every year and is staffed by a trained technician. The Foundation Programs Department sends invitations to clubs throughout the state to host the Hearing/Retinal Screening Unit.

WHAT DOES IT DETECT?

The mobile unit detects various eye diseases that can seriously impact vision if left untreated. The two photos below show how vision impacts two eye diseases the mobile unit detects.

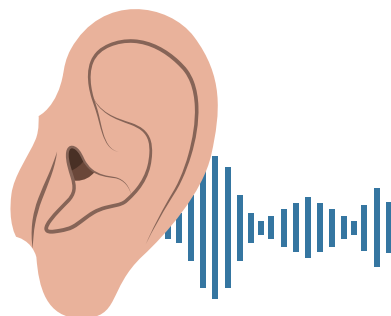


Retinopathy



Macular Degeneration

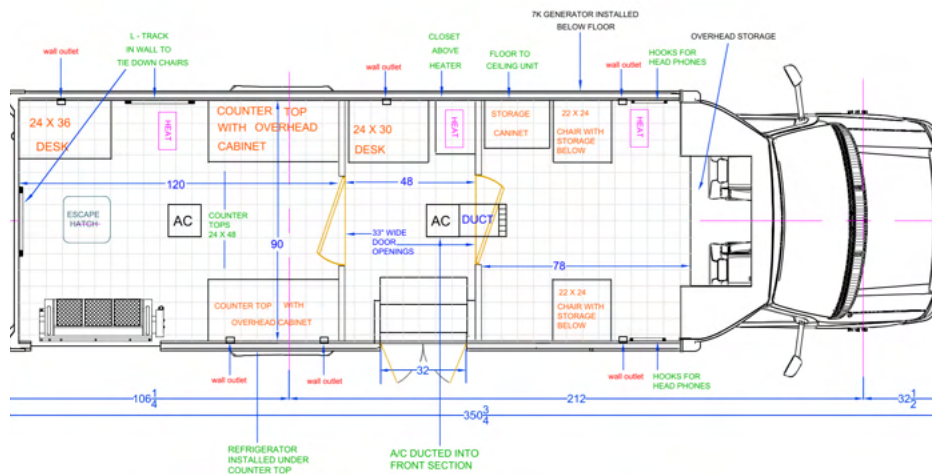
The mobile unit also detects hearing loss, which can impact children, adults, and senior citizens. Screenings are vital since some types of hearing loss are preventable.



The mobile unit has screened over **4,200** people for vision and hearing issues.
