



Social Services Department Update

Greetings Lions,

I hope you all will enjoy the upcoming holiday season. I wanted to give you all a brief update on the state of our hearing aid bank and some



information on a few of our partners.

For those who don't know, we have a **HEARING AID BANK** at the University of Illinois in Chicago (UIC).

We take all of the hearing aids that are donated to us and send them to the hearing aid bank at UIC where a group of audiologists catalogues and stores them until they are needed by one of our partnering clinics. The audiologists at UIC work closely with each clinic to determine what aid(s) are best for each client's hearing needs, those aids are then sent off to be reconditioned. And thanks to the kind and generous donations of our Lions we have many, many hearing aids.

If you, or someone you know is of low income and in need of hearing aids be sure to make use of our hearing aid program. If you need more information on the program feel free to go to our website www. LionsOfIlliniosFoundation.org or reach out to the Foundation office directly.



On another note, while we at the Foundation are very thankful for all the donations of **HEARING AID BATTARIES**, we would like to strongly urge you to instead donate those to local Long Term Care Facilities, Audiology Clinics or Food Pantries. By the time we receive the batteries, sort through them and then ship them off to one of our partners and then they need to find a patient who could use them, those batteries most of the time are past their use-thru date. So to make sure they get used and can help someone in your community, we would prefer you donate those batteries to somewhere local.



The Foundation Office **DOES NOT** collect, or distribute disposable **Contact Lenses**. We would again like to strongly urge you to instead donate those to your local Food Pantries and Shelters.

Social Services Department Update



"All-in-one" type Low Vision Machine

While on the topic of donations, I wanted to talk about LOW VISION READING MACHINES. We have many clubs who want to donate reading machines to the Foundation. While we greatly appreciate the generosity, we can only take reading machines that are "All in One" (please see photo). Some of the older models still have a Cathode Ray Tube (CRT) television, an old tube TV, that sits on a sliding base. Those older models tend to be very heavy and could prove to be hazardous. If you aren't sure, please send us a photo at LIFoffice@lifnd.org before donating.

If you are in need of a Low Vision Reader for someone in your community please contact us here at the Foundation office.

Lastly, I wanted to briefly talk about our partners over at Sorenson also known as Caption Call, and also ScripTalk.



Caption Call is a free device for those with hearing loss that uses a voice-to-text technology, assisted by



captioning agents and automated speech recognition, to transcribe your conversation so that the speakers' words appear on your Caption Call screen." This could be a great tool for those who are experiencing hearing loss, if someone gives you a call while you are on the device the entire conversation over the phone will





have captions. If you are interested in their free device you can find out more about it over at their website captioncall.com/.

ScripTalk is a device that you would have placed on your table. When you go to the pharmacy they will attach a small electronic tag to the prescription, and then when you set the prescription bottle on the ScripTalk Station Reader it would read that tag out loud to you. If you are struggling with being able to read your prescriptions maybe think about giving these guys a call to find out more.

That's all I got, happy holidays to all of you Lions, and make sure to stay warm!

Lions of Illinois Endowment Fund President

Dear Fellow Lions,

The Lions of Illinois Endowment fund is the future of your Foundation. There are so many ways to help support the growth of the fund like through a Foundation Fellow, an annual donation to Sustaining Supporter, Birdies for Charity, memorials, honorariums, get well wishes and the donations to the Tree of Service. All donations to the Endowment Fund will remain in the Endowment Fund – only the income from the fund can be used to fund the programs of the

Foundation and administration expenses. A club can make a \$500 donation for a Foundation Fellow, to honor a member of their Lions club or community.

A Lion member can also donate the \$500 for a Foundation Fellow for themselves. Lions can give \$25 annually into the Sustaining Supporter program which after 21 donations of \$25 will turn into a Foundation Fellow. For larger donations, you can purchase a leaf or rock on the Tree of Service. The leaves and rocks are engraved & mounted on the tree in the conference room at the Foundation office.

It is well lit and looks impressive from the road out front. All of these funds run through the Birdies Program with John Deere, and the John Deere Foundation this year matched 7% of the funds collected. This 7% bonus then comes back to your Endowment Fund. Another way to help support your Lions of Illinois Endowment Fund is through our Legacy Club Program. Individuals may choose to give a tax-deductible gift naming the Lions of Illinois Endowment Fund as a beneficiary of part of their estate. By making donations to the Endowment Fund, you are showing your support in helping build the Fund in order to ensure the continuation of the Foundation programs into the future.

Giving and helping others is a great feeling.


