

The Center for Sight & Hearing is coming to Peoria!

CSH is proud to announce our expansion into Central Illinois. We have been providing low-cost hearing and vision services to our region for over sixty years, in partnership with the Northern Illinois Lions Clubs. Now, we hope to bring that same level of service and dedication to Central Illinois.

What does CSH do exactly?

First, we are committed to providing low-cost hearing and vision services. This includes everything from exams and glasses, to social and support groups, to hearing aids and sign language classes. The Center strives to make these affordable for all, and we accept most major insurances, including Medicaid, the only provider in our region to do so.

Second, CSH provides vision rehabilitation services. This free training allows people who have little or no vision to live independently in their own homes. We currently partner with the Central Illinois Center for the Blind & Visually Impaired (CICBVI) to provide no-cost white-cane training, support groups, low vision aids, devices, and information sessions on low vision.

Finally, CSH hopes to be a builder of community. We are affiliated with like-minded agencies in Central Illinois, as well as the Illinois Department of Human Services, health departments, and universities. Our mission is to provide the best quality care at the lowest possible cost to our patients. We are passionate about serving people with vision and hearing loss, and we are excited to expand in Central Illinois.

We believe that with the help and support of the local Lions Clubs, we can provide more services to the region than ever before. As Hellen Keller said, "Alone we can do so little, together we can do so much." Thank you for supporting the Center for Sight & Hearing!

Sight and Sound Sweepstakes Individual Seller Cash Prizes Are Back!

Fourteen (14) individual prizes will be awarded to the Lions meeting the qualification listed below. The rules governing eligibility for the "Individual seller prizes" are displayed along with the breakdown of the prizes. <u>There are no exceptions to the</u> <u>eligibility requirements.</u>

Eligibility for Individual Seller Prizes:

1. Only Individual Lions are eligible to participate, clubs or groups are not eligible.

2. A minimum of twenty-five (25) complete books of three Sweepstakes tickets must be sold by the individual and listed on the bottom of the seller form to qualify for and award.

3. All completed Sweepstakes ticket stubs, related money and the completes "Individual Seller Form" must be returned together to the Foundation Office no later than May 1st. Prizes are:

- Four (4) State Top sweepstakes seller prizes of: \$500, \$350, \$250, and \$200.
- There will also be one top district seller prize of \$100 for each district in MD-1 lions.
