### **LETTER FROM...** Lions of Illinois Foundation Executive Director Lion Ronald Fruit, PDG

#### My fellow Lions,

My first quarter as your Executive Director has been very eventful. As I travel throughout the state attending Candy Day Jamborees and also presenting the history of this great Foundation, in the form of an additional seminar I have put together, I am humbled by our beginnings and what we have accomplished to date.

**"Moving Forward...Looking Back"** is the theme of our 50th Anniversary and moving into our sixty third year of our Biggest Fundraiser, Candy Day I am mindful that as we look forward, into the next fifty years of our Foundation, there is still so much more that we can accomplish together.

**Candy Day** as our largest fundraiser supporting about 20% of our annual budget. Candy Day this year will be held on October 13th-14th. A strong showing and participation in Candy Day starts the year out with a sound financial footing needed for our programs and services. Looking forward to our 2024 Candy Day, our board has voted to implement a new CD recognition level awards program. You will be receiving information, in the mail and at your district conventions, on this new program.

Our **Sight and Sound Sweepstakes** is our second largest Fundraiser. This is our 44th year holding this event, with the final drawing taking place at the state convention in May. As part of the "Looking Back...Moving Forward" theme, we have brought back the cash prizes for top sellers, and we have added 2 more tickets to the Sweepstakes Booklets for more chances to win! **Each booklet will now hold 5 tickets for the same price of \$10 per booklet**. Sweepstakes books will be available for the holiday season for those clubs who want the opportunity to have them early, contact our office and we will mail them to your club secretary. Don't forget about our **3 Early Bird drawings** that happen the first Wednesday in March, April and May.

We just finished our **29th annual Golf Classic**, which directly supports our Student Low Vision Program, which began in 1976 and serves over 300 students annually. The response from our golfers and Hole sponsors was overwhelming with a record \$21,865 net going towards our Student Low Vision Program. The 2024 Golf Classic will be held on Saturday, August 3rd and will mark the 30th Anniversary of this event!

LIF is also "moving forward" with new fundraisers with the goal of developing regional partnerships. The Center for Sight and Hearing is coming to Peoria and our LIF **Bingo Bonanza Fundraiser** is positioned to help support that move. This event will take place on September 30th at the Pekin VFW. LIF is working with Local Lions Clubs, the VFW and the Boys and Girls Club for this event.

As I continue to travel this year and next to your club meetings and district conventions, I am aware that there will be many more questions about our rich history and our future as a Foundation. To build on this, we have put together a **Townhall Zoom meeting** which will take place in January. There will also be an opportunity to submit questions and topics to be covered. A letter will go out to all clubs with more information.

Last but not least, our **50th Anniversary Gala Celebration** is booked for Saturday, September 28th, 2024, at the Hilton Lisle, Naperville by Double Tree with PIP, Douglas Alexander as our scheduled keynote speaker.

As I look back, I am keenly aware our success comes not from the action of one, but from the actions of all. By participating in Foundation fundraisers and programs, all Lions help to increase the number of people we serve. The support that comes from the Lions of MD-1 is remarkable. This support makes me proud to be a Lion in Illinois and excited to see what we can do, Moving Forward.

The Lions of Illinois Foundation partners with Spectrios Institute for Low Vision, the Illinois College of Optometry, and the Chicago Lighthouse for the Blind to provide a FREE comprehensive visual evaluation to Illinois students in grades K-12.

Students are referred by special education staff employed by the Illinois Board of Education. The exams are performed by licensed optometrists that travel to the different screening locations throughout the state.



The LIF Low Vision Program for Students provides a visually impaired child with the optical tools and training necessary to help prevent further vision loss or even blindness. But more importantly, these are the children we have promised to help by preserving what sight they have left. Their future is in our hands.
