My Fellow Lions,

The holiday season is fast approaching. This time of year, it is good to look back and see where we have been, we at the Foundation have a front row seat to see the continuous support from all the Lions throughout Illinois coming together. Our programs and services have touched many this year with Camp Lions, Student Low Vision, Adult Low Vision, and Mobile Screenings.

Camp Lions hosted 137 individuals with hearing and/or vision needs this summer. The Clubs did a great job of hosting treat nights that the campers enjoyed themselves. Our partners have provided over 300 Student Low Vision screenings. I was able to attend the Jacksonville Fall Clinic and witness the level of complexity and compassion for each comprehensive exam performed. Every week, our partners teach Orientation and Mobility training as part of our Adult Low Vision Program, providing effective and safe navigation techniques. The Mobile Screening Unit has completed 130, Club hosted, events with 1,739 individuals screened to date, 97 of those screened were at risk for Macular Degeneration and 616 were screened as having a hearing loss.

The impact of the Foundation continues to grow as we help those with Vision and Hearing needs. These successes have come about not because of one large donation or one grand gesture, our programs succeed because of each and every donation, whether it be large or small, they come together to impact those we serve. Our Foundation exists to be a conduit for all, working together to create a permanent vehicle for those with vision and hearing needs in Illinois.

It is great to be a Lion in Illinois and be part of all that our Foundation does. The season of caring reinforces the importance of what we do as Lions and how the Foundation is an important part of that community service. The Foundation staff and I wish all our fellow Lions, Happy Holidays and warm wishes for the New Year.

Adult Low-Vision

What is O&M Training? Orientation and Mobility training focuses on instructing individuals who are blind or low vision with safe and effective travel skills through their environment. Common techniques taught through O&M training include cane travel, locating objects, navigating street crossings, and more.



Dear Fellow Lions,

I want to reiterate how happy we are for all your time and effort at the Bingo Bonanza!

Your help allows us to continue our low vision services in Central Illinois, including demonstration and instruction on low vision aids, instruction on assistive technology software and equipment, daily living and communication skills, orientation and mobility training, human guide methods, and support groups for those dealing with vision loss.

Our research shows there are approximately 20,500 Central Illinoisans over the age of 18 who have vision loss or blindness due to glaucoma, macular degeneration, diabetic retinopathy, other genetic diseases, traumatic brain injury, or stroke. We anticipate that number will double by 2050, so your support means more than ever.

Thank you to all of the volunteers, sponsors, donors, and players for a great event! And a special shout out to the Pekin Lions for their gracious hospitality. We look forward to the next Bingo Bonanza, which will allow us to bring more Center for Sight & Hearing services to your communities.




