



LETTER FROM...Lions of Illinois Endowment Fund President, Terry Knollenberg, PCC

Welcome 2024-2025 Lions of Illinois Foundation Trustees. It is with great pleasure I take the helm of our Lions of Illinois Endowment Fund. I will do my best to lead our organization in the furtherance of our vision to become a permanent vehicle for the continued operation of our programs and services. This is

more clearly explained on our website, "lionsofillinoisfoundation.org" under Lions of Illinois Endowment Fund.

We have heard about the \$20 million dollar target that will provide us the funds necessary to continue providing services to those in our state that have visual and hearing issues. I believe that number is outdated and should be raised and our Executive Director is looking into it.

You might wonder why a vision such as ours was conceived. I believe it was because a Trustee or perhaps several Trustees saw the need for permanency. In 1997 MD-1 had over 30,000 Lions while today we have around 12,000. If this trend continues, we well have too few Lions to provide donations for our programs and services to continue as they are. Our Endowment Fund, properly sized, will be able to continue our work as our numbers decline.

Other ways to help in this process for our ability to continue providing funding for our programs and services is for each of you to become a Foundation Fellow or a Progressive Foundation Fellow and to visit your clubs and encourage them to donate to our programs and participate in all our fundraising events. You can use your weekly donation reports from Andrew to help with this.

Please plan your visits well and make your visits a welcome addition to your club's meetings.
