

SIGHT AND SOUND SWEEPSTAKES CLUB DONATION FORM

The Early Bird Drawing is the **first Wednesday of March, April and May**. Sold books and money must be turned into the Foundation Office by 3pm on the **Tuesday before the drawing**.

Because of the 3 Early Bird Drawings, Clubs may need to submit multiple club reports. Our System will combine individual reports into a FINAL report for your club. Please feel free to make a copy of this form to send in with each shipment of Tickets and money or you may send in just one Final Report at the conclusion of the Fundraiser.

- Do not detach the Ticket Book cover from the ticket stubs; you may trim the ticket cover to be the same length as the torn ticket stubs or perforation.
- Package ticket stubs in a strong box or envelope and reinforce with tape.
- Return this form (and any others) with your check payable to Lions of Illinois Foundation. Monies must accompany your books to be entered into any of the drawings, this includes the 3 Early Bird Drawings.
- A **Minimum of 10 Books**, need to be sold, for your club to receive a refund. Please indicate a % below.
- The Club Award Form is to be filled out for a Club who is donating 100% of the funds, requesting Zero percent back. This indicates that LIF Programs will receive all the ticket monies collected by the Club.
- Please do not keep your 40% refund, if your club is to receive a refund, Your Foundation will remit to your club the refund amount within 4 weeks from the last drawing in May.

INTRODUCTION

Sight and Sound Sweepstakes, the second largest fundraiser of our Lions of Illinois Foundation (LIF), started with the 1981 campaign. Funds generated by the outstanding efforts of the Lions Clubs of Illinois have helped strengthen the programs and services provided through the Foundation. The Sweepstakes campaign starts in January and concludes with the drawing at the annual Lions of Illinois Foundation Breakfast at the State convention in May. Even though the real winners are those that we assist through our programs and services, there are 26 prize winners, and possibly as many Lion winners who have sold a winning ticket.

Some of the programs and services are: Retinal/Hearing Screening Unit, Camp Lions, Low Vision Clinics, Social Services and Referrals, Used Hearing Aid Bank and Used Eyeglasses/Hearing Aid Collections. Lions of Illinois Funds for Emergency (L.I.F.E.) Equally as important is the fact that these funds are to be used in assisting local Clubs with sight and hearing related activities.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR RETURNING SWEEPSTAKES TICKET BOOKS

DO NOT USE THE U.S. POSTAL SERVICE


Have all Club members return the SWEEPS books **and** money to you (Club Secretary or Chairperson).

To avoid errors and confusion, return all Sweepstakes tickets **and** money to our Lions of Illinois Foundation (LIF) in one package. Using the envelope provided, UPS your package to our Lions of Illinois Foundation:

TO DECREASE SHIPPING COSTS:

1. SWEEPS books with **all** tickets sold: cut the front cover to the same length as the ticket stubs. **DO NOT** separate ticket covers from ticket stubs.
2. Partial SWEEPS books: cut the front cover to the same length as the ticket stubs. Leave the unsold tickets in the book.
3. Except for checks made out to our Lions of Illinois Foundation, deposit all money and checks in your club's account and write a single Club check to cover the total amount due. Make the check payable to: **Lions of Illinois Foundation**
4. All SWEEPS books sold or unsold, should be returned to our Lions of Illinois Foundation office by May 11th.
5. Lions members, entering to win one of the Individual Seller prizes, must have their package (see "Individual Seller Prize form," for complete details) to our LIF office no later than **May 11th**.

VALUE IN PARTICIPATING

Between 19,000 and 20,000 children and adults in Illinois have received these free services or benefited from the services provided through your Foundation. Those with vision and hearing needs hope that all Lions Clubs will consider contributing 100% of their SWEEPS proceeds to support the programs and services of our Foundation.

The following are a few examples of how your club benefits from your Foundation programs: whenever a child from your community attends Camp Lions Free of charge; a screening unit arrives in your town and offers free screenings; a child is screened in your community through our Low Vision Program; someone from your community finds medical help at reduced rates through your Foundation. A Club is also allowed to spend up to 40% of their proceeds on Club related sight and hearing projects.

ARE RAFFLES LEGAL?

Yes, raffles are legal for groups, such as the Lions, under Illinois Public Act 81-1365. The law authorizes counties and municipalities to license certain organizations to operate raffles.

WHO MAY SELL SWEEPSTAKES TICKETS?

Ticket sellers **must** be at least 18 years old and under the wording of the law must be a "bonafide" member of the sponsoring organization.

EARLY BIRD RAFFLE

\$1,500.00 in additional prize money for our Early Bird Drawing. **This is a cumulative drawing. All money must accompany tickets in order to be entered into the drawing.**

LIF will do a monthly drawing for the months of March, April, and May. If your ticket does not get pulled in March, it will then get placed into the April drawing. If your ticket does not get pulled in April, it will go into May's drawing. These tickets will then go into the main Sweepstakes drawing on May 17th. Early Bird prize money will be split 50/50. \$250.00 will go to the Club and \$250.00 will go to the seller listed on the back of the winning ticket. **The drawings will take place the first Wednesday of March, April and May.**

We highly encourage all clubs to participate in the Early Bird Drawing. Do not miss this opportunity to earn more money for your Club and participating members. GOOD LUCK!



SWEEEPSTAKES PRIZE LIST

Each year, twenty-six (26) cash prizes totaling \$19,250 are awarded from the Sweepstakes campaign. The \$5,000 grand prize is followed with an additional five (5) \$1,000 prizes, ten (10) \$500 prizes, and ten (10) \$250 prizes. Sellers of winning tickets, who have completed the back of the winning ticket, will receive \$500 for the Grand Prize, \$100 for a \$1,000 ticket, \$50 for a \$500 ticket, and \$25 for a \$250 ticket. **If a seller does not complete the seller's information on a winning ticket, their share will be forfeited to your LIF.**

If requested, Clubs donating 100% of their funds to our Foundation will receive a 100% patch for their Club Banner. Clubs that already have a patch will receive a yearly Chevron to go under the patch.

The individual Lion that sells ten (10) or more Sweepstakes books can receive a Sight & Sound Sweepstakes pin. The Seller that already has a pin can receive a small tab to attach to their pin. The pin or tab must be requested.

Individual Seller Cash Prizes

Fourteen (14) individual prizes will be awarded to Lions meeting the qualifications listed below. The rules governing eligibility for the "Individual Seller Prizes" are displayed along with the breakdown of the prizes. **There are no exceptions to the eligibility requirements.**

Eligibility for Individual Seller Prizes:

1. Only Individual Lions are eligible to participate, clubs or groups are not eligible.
2. A minimum of twenty-five (25) complete books of three Sweepstakes tickets must be sold by the individual and listed on the bottom of the seller form to qualify for an award.
3. All completed Sweepstakes ticket stubs, related money and the complete "Individual Seller Form" must be returned together to the Foundation Office no later than May 1st.

Prizes are:

- **Four (4) State Top Sweepstakes Seller Prizes of: \$500, \$350, \$250, and \$200.**
- There will also be **one (1) Top District Seller Prize of \$100** for each district in MD-1.
- If a tie results among any of the Top State Seller Prizes, those individuals involved will split the associated prizes.
- The winner in each district will be the top seller of sweepstakes tickets not receiving a state top seller prize.
